

About my TFP shoots

Sometimes I do photo shoots on a TFP basis. TFP stands for Time For Photos. It is an arrangement in which I agree to provide the model with a certain number of photographs from the session, and a release or license to use those pictures in return for the model's time.

TFP shoots can be done when both the model and the photographer gain something for their portfolio. A TFP shoots mean that this is a shoot without actual payment for the model or for me as the photographer.

I will have certain rules regarding these TFP shoots. These are as follows:

Selection of photos

- As the photographer, I will make a selection from the images that I will use for post processing and delivery. The model is allowed to declare their preferences during the shoot but the final decision on which photos are processed and delivered rests with me as the photographer.

Delivery to the model

- The model will receive 10-20 photos in a digital format (jpeg) that are suitable for presentation on smartphones, computers, social media etc
- The model receives the photos within one week after the shoot
- All delivered photos are high-resolution, post-processed photos.
- The model does **not** receive the RAW files

Usage of photos

- The model is **not** allowed to further edit or crop the photo. Ask me to do so when a different variant is required.
- The model is allowed to publish the photos on social media and other websites.
- I can use the photos on my website, social media channels and other websites.
- If I post the photos, I will only use the first name of the model or their preferred nom de plume.
- If the model posts the photos, I will be credited as the photographer and my web site (www.stevetaborphotos.com) will be cited.
- I am allowed to use these photos for photographic contests.
- Both I and the model are allowed to use the photos for commercial purposes.
